- 1. The Parent(s) and/or Legal Guardian(s) of the minor participant will instruct the (minor) participant that, prior to participating in the below CLUB WEST activity or event, he or she should inspect the facilities and equipment to be used, and, if he or she believes anything to be unsafe, the participant should immediately advise the officials of such condition and refuse to participate. Likewise the Adult Participant shall follow the above mentioned guidelines. I understand and agree that, if at any time, I feel anything to be UNSAFE, I shall immediately take all precautions to avoid the unsafe area and REFUSE TO PARTICIPATE further.
- 2. I/We fully understand and acknowledge that:
